#### (AMENDMENT No. 26) ORDER 2019

##### Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intends to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), 4 (1) and (2), 32 (1), 35 (1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order:-

The effect of the made Order will be to add additional roads into the Addington Residents Permit Zone, to add Virtual Permits into the order and to introduce new or remove disabled persons parking bays (DPPB) on the following length of roads:-

#### Roads in Broadstairs

**BRADSTOW WAY** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 121. **CROW HILL** - (DPPB) Across the front of number 20. **VICTORIA PARADE** – (DPPB) On the eastern side 18 metres opposite the southern kerb of Wrotham Road for a distance of 31 metres in a southerly direction (2 Bays).

#### Roads in Margate

**BRYON AVENUE** – (DPPB) Across the front of Number 79. **DANE HILL** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 1. **HAROLD ROAD** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 42. **MILTON AVENUE** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 52. **PRICES AVENUE** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 37. **RIVERHEAD CLOSE** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 6. **WESTBROOK AVENUE** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 28. **WESTCLIFF ROAD** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 15A. **ZION PLACE** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 9. To remove (DPPB) in **HASTINGS AVENUE** – Across the front of number 11. **MILTON AVENUE** – Across the front of number 103. To add the following roads into Margate Addington Residents Zone – **CECIL SQUARE** Property No. 9 only, **CHURCHFIELDS**, **VICARGE PLACE** AND **WHEATLEY PLACE**.

#### Roads in Ramsgate

**CHERITON AVENUE** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 4. **DANE PARK ROAD** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 5. **DENMARK ROAD** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 22. **PROSPECT TERRACE** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 11. **ST MILDREDS ROAD** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 48. **SYDNEY ROAD** – (DPPB) Across the front of number 26. To remove the (DPPB) in **CHERITON AVENUE** – Across the front of number 2.

The Order was made on 11 November 2019 and its provisions will come into effect on 18 November 2019.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

The Kent County Council, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers and under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

"The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Thanet) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2014" ('the Order of 2014') shall have effect as though:

**In the Articles to the Order of 2014**

**PART A**

**The following to be added in correct sequence-**

**INTERPRETATION**

"Business Parking Permit" means a parking permit issued under the provisions of Part K of this Order and

"hand-held device" means a piece of computing equipment that can be used in the hand, such as a smartphone or tablet computer used for parking enforcement and to view electronic records;

"Hotel Parking Permit" means a parking permit issued under the provisions of Part J of this Order and "hotels permit holder" means a person, business, partnership or company being proprietors of a full service hotel registered with Visit England and AA Hotel Service located within the District of Thanet to whom such a permit has been issued;

"parking permit" means a permit or virtual parking permit of the type described in an item in column 2 of the Table to Article 60.

"Residents' Parking Permit" means a parking permit issued under the provisions of Part K of this Order and "residents' permit holder" means a person to whom such a permit has been issued;

"virtual parking permits" means an electronic record of a parking permit issued and confirmed by Thanet District Council or other authorised agent to exempt a vehicle from a restriction in a relevant parking place and displayed on a hand-held device;

"Visitors' Parking Permit" means a parking permit issued under the provisions of Part L of this Order and "visitors' permit holder" means a person to or for whom such permit has been issued.

The following Articles shall be deleted and replaced with the following entries:

**PARKING PLACES WITH TICKET MACHINES**

- 19 (1) SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the chargeable hours in a charged parking place unless it is a vehicle of the permitted class and unless the parking charge has been paid

PROVIDED ALWAYS the payment of the parking charge shall be indicated by the vehicle displaying in the relevant position a parking ticket issued by the ticket machine relating to the parking place in which the vehicle has been left unless payment for parking for that parking place has been made by "pay by phone".

(2) SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the chargeable hours in a charged parking place for longer than the parking period paid for on payment of the parking charge.

(3) No vehicle which has been taken away from a parking space in a charged parking place during the chargeable hours after a parking charge has been incurred, shall until the expiration of one hour from the time it was taken away again be left in that parking place during the chargeable hours.

(4) Nothing in this Article shall apply in respect of

(a) any vehicle which is waiting in a charged parking place in accordance with a provision of Part G of this Order; or

(b) any vehicle which is waiting in a charged parking place which is also a residents' parking place and has a virtual parking permit or is displaying in the relevant position a valid Parking Permit issued, or a valid Visitors' Parking Permit validated in respect of that vehicle for the Residents' Parking Zone in which that charged parking place is included.

#### **HOTEL PARKING PLACES**

20 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle other than a vehicle which has a virtual parking permit or is displaying in the relevant position a valid Parking Permit issued for the Zone in which that Parking place is situated to wait at any time in any of the parking places described in Part 2 of the Fifth Schedule to this order.

#### **ELECTRIC VEHICLE PARKING PLACES**

21 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle which has a virtual parking permit or is displaying in the relevant position a valid Parking Permit issued for the Zone in which that Parking Place is situated to wait at any time in any of the parking places described in Part 6 of the Fifth Schedule to this Order:

#### **SHARED PARKING PLACES - PARKING PERIOD 1 HOUR**

22 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle which is displaying in the relevant position

(i) a valid Parking Permit issued, or

(ii) a valid Visitors' Parking Permit validated in respect of that vehicle for the Zone in which that Parking Place is situated, or

(iii) has a valid virtual parking permit issued,

to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays, in

any of the parking places described in Part 2 of the Fifth Schedule to this Order:-

(i) for a longer period than one hour, or

(ii) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road, or

(iii) has a valid virtual parking permit issued,

#### **SHARED PARKING PLACES - PARKING PERIOD 2 HOURS**

23 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle which is displaying in the relevant position

(i) a valid Parking Permit issued, or

(ii) a valid Visitors' Parking Permit validated in respect of that vehicle for the Zone in which that Parking Place is situated, or

(iii) has a valid virtual parking permit issued,

to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays, in any of the parking places described in Part 3 of the Fifth Schedule to this Order:-

(i) for a longer period than two hours, or

(ii) if a period of less than two hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road, or

(iii) has a valid virtual parking permit issued,

#### **SHARED PARKING PLACES - PARKING PERIOD 4 HOURS**

24 SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle which is displaying in the relevant position

(i) a valid Parking Permit issued, or

(ii) a valid Visitors' Parking Permit validated in respect of that vehicle for the Zone in which that Parking Place is situated, or

(iii) has a valid virtual parking permit issued,

to wait between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays, in any of the parking places described in Part 4 of the Fifth Schedule to this Order:-

(i) for a longer period than four hours, or

(ii) if a period of less than four hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road, or

(iii) has a valid virtual parking permit issued,

## **TICKET MACHINES TO BE INSTALLED AT PARKING PLACES**

53 (1) There shall be a ticket machine on or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Fourth Schedule.

(2) No parking charge shall be payable in respect of any vehicle waiting in a designated parking place during the chargeable hours if

(a) at the time the vehicle was left in that parking place there was on the ticket machine relating to that parking place a notice placed by any person duly authorised by the Council indicating that the ticket machine relating to that parking place is out of order; and

(b) there is no other ticket machine available to be used for that parking place; and

(c) the vehicle is removed within one hour of the ticket machine defect being rectified, and

(d) the "pay by phone" system is not available.

PROVIDED ALWAYS that if any such vehicle is not removed within that period the parking charge shall be treated as having been incurred and paid at the time when the vehicle was left in the parking place and all the provisions of this Order shall apply accordingly.

## **PAYMENT OF PARKING CHARGE**

54 (1) The parking charge shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in a parking place referred to in the Fourth Schedule by the insertion in the ticket machine to the parking place in which the vehicle is left of coins to the value of the parking charge or by payment of the appropriate parking charge by the "pay by phone" system and showing on the hand-held device.

(2) Payment of the parking charge for any vehicle left during the chargeable hours in a parking place referred to in the Fourth Schedule shall be indicated by the issue by the ticket machine relating to that parking place of a numbered parking ticket indicating the amount of parking charge which has been paid, and by the exhibition of that parking ticket on the vehicle in the relevant position or by the electronic recording of the event on the "pay by phone" system and showing on the hand-held device.

(3) No parking charge shall be payable in respect of any vehicle waiting in a designated parking place during the chargeable hours in accordance with the provisions of Part G of this Order.

## **INDICATION OF EXPIRY OF PARKING PERIOD**

55 The expiry of the parking period for which the parking charge has been paid for a vehicle left in a parking place referred to in the Fourth Schedule shall be indicated when there is exhibited on the vehicle a parking ticket issued by the ticket machine relating to the parking place in which the vehicle is left showing the day and time of payment of the charge, and the time shown on the clock on the said ticket machine is more than the duration of the parking period later than the time shown on that parking ticket or by the expiry of the period for which a charge has been paid by the "pay by phone" system and electronic notification of such to the council or agent.

## **INDICATIONS BY TICKET MACHINES AND PARKING TICKETS AS EVIDENCE**

56 If at any time when a vehicle is left in a parking place during the permitted hours the

clock on the ticket machine relating to the parking place in which the vehicle is left and on the parking ticket exhibited on the vehicle or hand-held device give the indication given in the preceding Article, it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved that the parking charge has been duly paid, and the parking period for which payment was made by the parking charge has already expired.

#### APPLICATIONS FOR PERMITS

- 61 On receipt of any application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this part of the Order and of the appropriate remittance the Council, upon being satisfied that the applicant is the owner of a permitted class of vehicle as described in an item in column 4 of the Table to Article 60 and meets the qualification requirement described in column 3 of the corresponding item may issue to the applicant one Virtual Parking Permit or a Parking Permit for the leaving in a parking place in the Zone indicated on the permit of the vehicle to which such Parking Permit relates by the owner of such vehicle or by any person using such vehicle with the consent of the owner other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward.

#### VISITORS PARKING PERMITS

- 70 Any resident may apply to the Council for the issue of one or more books of Visitors' Parking Permits or a Virtual Parking Permit for a vehicle or vehicles of the classes described in the Table to Article 60 of this Order and belonging to a person or persons visiting that resident and any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied and shall be accompanied by the appropriate remittance.
