TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Openreach works.

To allow fibre works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Addington Street & Albert Street, Ramsgate.

Closures are planned from 13th October 2025, with estimated completion by 17th October 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WGGD360B-02 - Openreach) & (BC411002WGGD360B-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Addington Street will be closed outside number 4b to outside number 25, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Albert Street will be closed outside number 57, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing fibre works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Openreach.

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Addington Street, Townley Street, Royal Road, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Grange Road, West Cliff Road, Hertford Street, Albert Street and vice versa.
Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
