TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

UK Power Networks works.

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bedlam Court Lane, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 24th March 2025, with estimated completion by 28th March 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50078421373-01 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Bedlam Court Lane will be closed outside Quartacre, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing utility works to be carried out, works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bedlam Court Lane, Foxborough Lane, Tothill Street, High Street, Church Street and vice versa. Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
