TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

HW Martin Traffic Management Ltd works.

To allow drainage works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Duncan Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 24th January 2025, with estimated completion by 24th January 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE10076255953-01 - Kent). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Duncan Road will be closed 40m South of the junction of Ellington Road, between the hours of 09:00 and 17:00 only, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing drainage works to be carried out, works are undertaken by HW Martin Traffic Management Ltd.

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Duncan Road, Crescent Road, South Eastern Road, Ellington Road and vice versa.
Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
