THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Southern Water works.

To allow water works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Harbour Street, Ramsgate. The one-way Order will be suspended to allow access.

Restrictions are planned from 17th November 2025, with estimated completion by 21st November 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT14367073-04 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Harbour Street will be closed outside number 17, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The one-way Order will be suspended from outside number 17 to the junction of B2054 Madeira Walk, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing water works to be carried out works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2054 Madeira Walk, B2054 Wellington Crescent, Plains Of Waterloo and King Street. Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
