THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2026

Southern Water works.

To allow water works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hardres Street, Ramsgate. The one-way Order will be suspended to allow access.

The restrictions are planned from 12th January 2026, with estimated completion by 14th January 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT14426260-02 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Hardres Street will be closed at the side of 51 High Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The one-way will be suspended between the junctions of High Street and Broad Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing water works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via High Street, Church Hill, Broad Street and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
