TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Southern Water works.

To allow water works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hardres Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 22nd September 2025, with estimated completion by 26th September 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT14298322-02 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Hardres Street will be closed outside number 1, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing water works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Hardres Street, Broad Street, Church Hill and High Street.
Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
