THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

SGN works.

To allow gas works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of High Street, Ramsgate. The one-way Order will be suspended to allow access.

Restrictions are planned from 12th May 2025, with estimated completion by 20th May 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW071W121118200-00658-01 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

High Street will be closed opposite number 47, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The one-way Order will be suspended between the junctions of Queen Street and George Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing gas works to be carried out, works are undertaken by SGN.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Queen Street, Effingham Street, George Street and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
