TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Southern Water works.

To allow water works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of High Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 22nd October 2025, with estimated completion by 28th October 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT14334208-01 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

High Street will be closed outside 101A Flat 1, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing water works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any Eastbound through traffic is via High Street, Chatham Street, A255 Boundary Road, King Street, Broad Street and Church Hill.

**The alternative route for any Westbound through traffic is via Hardres Street, A255 Boundary Road, Chatham Street and High Street.
Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
