**TEMPORARY ORDER 2025**

**Openreach works.**

**To allow fibre works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of King Street, Ramsgate.**

**A closure is planned from 7th July 2025, with estimated completion by 11th July 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411002WG7CP95V-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).**

**King Street will be closed from outside number 142 to outside number 146, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.**

**The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing fibre works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Openreach.**

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via King Street, B2054 Victoria Road, B2054 Victoria Parade, B2054 Wellington Crescent, Plains Of Waterloo and vice versa.**

**Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
