THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Southern Water works.

To allow water works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of King Street, Ramsgate. The one-way Order will be suspended to allow access.

Restrictions are planned from 30th October 2025, with estimated completion by 5th November 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT14291864-04 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

King Street will be closed from outside number 25 to outside number 27 and outside number 32, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The one-way Order will be suspended between the junctions of Brunswick Street and Broad Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing water works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via King Street, Brunswick Street, Turner Street, Broad Street and vice versa.
Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
