TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Ramsgate Town Council works.

To allow removal and disconnection of Christmas lights, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of King Street, Queen Street & York Street, Ramsgate.

Closures are planned from 2nd June 2025, with estimated completion by 6th June 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE10083086420-01 - Kent), (GE10060373137-01 - Kent) & (GE10069940174-01 - Kent). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Closures will be between the hours of 00:30 and 06:00 only.

King Street will be closed between the junctions of Plains of Waterloo and Broad Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Plains Of Waterloo, B2054 Wellington Crescent, B2054 Madeira Walk, Harbour Street and vice versa.

Queen Street will be closed between the junctions of King Street and Elms Avenue, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Queen Street, West Cliff Road, Royal Road, B2054 Paragon, B2054 Royal Parade, B2054 Harbour Parade, Harbour Street and vice versa.

The alternative route for any HGV through traffic is via Queen Street, West Cliff Road, B2054 Grange Road, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Paragon, B2054 Royal Parade, B2054 Harbour Parade, Harbour Street and vice versa.

York Street will be closed the entire length, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2054 Harbour Parade, Harbour Street and Queen Street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing removal and disconnection Christmas lights, works are undertaken by Ramsgate Town Council.
