Openreach works.

To allow fibre works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Liverpool Lawn, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 12th August 2025, with estimated completion by 13th August 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WG3V873F-03 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Liverpool Lawn will be closed from outside number 11 to outside number 19, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00 only, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing fibre works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Openreach.

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Liverpool Lawn, Albert Street, Adelaide Gardens and vice versa.
Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
