TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Kent County Council works.

To allow resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Princess Margaret Avenue, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 20th October 2025, with estimated completion by 31st October 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40190211851-02 - Kent). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Princess Margaret Avenue will be closed between the junctions of Melbourne Avenue and Auckland Avenue, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing resurfacing works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Melbourne Avenue, St Johns Avenue, St Johns Crescent, Auckland Avenue, Princess Margaret Avenue and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
