SGN works.

To allow gas works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Queen Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 3rd November 2025, with estimated completion by 6th November 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW314W121911761-01062-02 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Queen Street will be closed from outside number 44 to outside number 46, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing gas works to be carried out, works are undertaken by SGN.

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Queen Street, West Cliff Road, B2054 Grange Road, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Paragon, B2054 Royal Parade, Westcliff Arcade, Leopold Street and vice versa.
Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
