TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Kent County Council works.

To allow routine maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A299 Royal Harbour Approach, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned in 6 phases as detailed below:

Phase 1 - From 8th July 2025, with estimated completion by 8th July 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40111406483-01 - Kent).

Phase 2 - From 5th August 2025, with estimated completion by 5th August 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40111406483-01 - Kent).

Phase 3 - From 9th September 2025, with estimated completion by 9th September 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40111406483-01 - Kent).

Phase 4 - From 7th October 2025, with estimated completion by 7th October 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40111406483-01 - Kent).

Phase 5 - From 4th November 2025, with estimated completion by 4th November 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40111406483-01 - Kent).

Phase 6 - From 9th December, with estimated completion by 9th December 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40111406483-01 - Kent).

The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

A299 Royal Harbour Approach will be closed the entire length, between the hours of 08:30 and 18:00 only, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing routine maintenance works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A255 Canterbury Road East, A255 Nethercourt Circus Roundabout, B2054 London Road, B2054 Grange Road, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Paragon, B2054 Royal Parade, Military Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
