THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2026

Southern Water works.

To allow water works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Royal Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 22nd January 2026, with estimated completion by 28th January 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT14434334-01 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Royal Road will be closed outside number 62, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing water works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via West Cliff Road, B2054 Grange Road and B2054 St Augustines Road.
Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
