TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

SGN works.

To allow gas works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of St Lukes Avenue, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 30th June 2025, with estimated completion by 7th July 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW071W121248924-01241-02 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

St Lukes Avenue will be closed outside number 1, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing gas works to be carried out, works are undertaken by SGN.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A255 Hereson Road, A255 Boundary Road, Hardres Road, St Lukes Avenue and vice versa. Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
