Openreach works. **KENT COUNTY COUNCIL Public Notice** **Turner Street, Ramsgate** **(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)** **THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984** **TEMPORARY ORDER 2025**

Openreach works.

To allow fibre works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Turner Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 2nd June 2025, with estimated completion by 6th June 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WG4D0M8L-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Turner Street will be closed from outside number 3 to outside number 20, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing fibre works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any Northbound through traffic is via Broad Street, Hardres Street and Staffordshire Street.

The alternative route for any Southbound through traffic is via Turner Street, Staffordshire Street, Hardres Street, A255 Boundary Road, King Street and Broad Street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
