TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Openreach works.

To allow fibre works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Vale Square, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 6th May 2025, with estimated completion by 7th May 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WG2RCF0B-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Vale Square will be closed between the junctions of Crescent Road and Harrison Road, between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00 only, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing fibre works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Vale Square, Crescent Road, West Cliff Road, Cannonbury Road, Florence Road, Harrison Road and vice versa. Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
