THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2026

SGN works.

To allow gas works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Various Roads, Ramsgate.

Closures will be carried out in 5 phases as detailed below:

Phase 1 - South Eastern Road will be closed from 5th January 2026, with estimated completion by 18th January 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW200W121873151-01194-03 - SGN).

Crescent Road will be closed from 5th January 2026, with estimated completion by 18th January 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW200W121873178-00352-03 - SGN).

Phase 2 - Ellington Road will be closed from 19th January 2026, with estimated completion by 1st February 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW200W121873197-00471-03 - SGN).

South Eastern Road will be closed from 19th January 2026, with estimated completion by 1st February 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW200W121873181-01194-03 - SGN).

Phase 3 - South Eastern Road will be closed from 2nd February 2026, with estimated completion by 1st March 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW200W121873211-01194-04 - SGN).

Phase 4 - South Eastern Road will be closed from 2nd March 2026, with estimated completion by 15th March 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW200W121873263-01194-04 - SGN).

High Street will be closed from 2nd March 2026, with estimated completion by 15th March 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW200W121873223-00658-04 - SGN).

Phase 5 - South Eastern Road will be closed from 16th March 2026, with estimated completion by 5th April 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW200W121873280-01194-04 - SGN).

The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Phase 1 - South Eastern Road will be closed at the junction of Crescent Road.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via South Eastern Road, Ellington

Road, Grange Road, Crescent Road and vice versa.

Crescent Road will be closed at the junction of South Eastern Road.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Crescent Road, Grange Road, Vale Road, Crescent Road and vice versa.

Phase 2 - South Eastern Road will be closed at the junction of Ellington Road.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via South Eastern Road, Crescent Road, Grange Road, A255 Park Road, High Street, South Eastern Road and vice versa.

Ellington Road will be closed at the junction of South Eastern Road.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Ellington Road, Cannon Road, High Street, A255 Park Road, Grange Road, Ellington Road and vice versa.

Phase 3 - South Eastern Road will be closed between the junctions of Ellington Road and High Street.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via South Eastern Road, High Street, A255 Park Road, Grange Road, Ellington Road and vice versa.

Phase 4 - South Eastern Road will be closed at the junction of High Street.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via South Eastern Road, Ellington Road, Grange Road, A255 Park Road, South Eastern Road and vice versa.

High Street will be closed at the junction of South Eastern Road.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via High Street, Chatham Street, A255 Park Road, High Street and vice versa.

Phase 5 - South Eastern Road will be closed between the junctions of High Street and A255 Park Road,

The alternative route for any through traffic is via South Eastern Road, A255 Park Road, High Street and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing gas works to be carried out, works are undertaken by SGN.
