TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Southern Water works.

To allow water works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Vereth Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 24th November 2025, with estimated completion by 28th November 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT14379850-01 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#).

Vereth Road will be closed outside number 9, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing water works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.

There is no alternative route. Every effort will be made to maintain access for residents whenever it is safe to do so.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
