COTTAGE ROAD, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow sewer repair works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Cottage Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 18 May 2020, with completion currently expected by 29 May 2020.

Cottage Road will be closed in the general vicinity of 2 East Cliff Mews, with local access from either direction up to where the road is closed.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Wellington Crescent, Albion Place, Abbot's Hill, Camden Road and Hibernia Street

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [Southern Water Permit LQ001SWAT10393775], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
