**A254 MARGATE ROAD,
BROADSTAIRS & RAMSGATE**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of A254 Margate Road, Broadstairs and Ramsgate.

Overnight closures are planned from Wednesday 7 October 2020 for up to 9 weekday nights, between 19:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

A254 Margate Road will be closed between the junctions with New Cross Road and B2014 Newington Road.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via A254 Margate Road, A256 Westwood Road and Northwood Road.

Highfield Road and Coxes Lane will be closed at their junctions with Margate Road, with access continuing from their alternative junctions.

Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for residents and businesses, including access to Quantock Gardens and Homeleigh Road, when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.
