A254 MARGATE ROAD, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A254 Margate Road, Ramsgate.

Overnight closures are planned from Wednesday 13 October 2021 for up to 4 weekday nights, from 19:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

A254 Margate Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the junctions with junctions with College Road and Princes Road, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A254 Margate Road, Pearce Signs Roundabout, A256 Haine Road, New Haine Road, Haine Road, Lord of the Manor Interchange, A299 Canterbury Road East, A255 Nethercourt Circus, Nethercourt Hill, High Street St Lawrence, Park Road and Shah Place.

College Road and Princes Road will be closed at their junctions with A254 Margate Road at certain times as the works progress, with access continuing from their other junctions.

Local access to the remainder of A254 Margate Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.
