



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**A255 HERESON ROAD, RAMSGATE**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

To allow sewer repair works to be carried out part of an ongoing programme to update Thanet's sewers, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of A255 Hereson Road, Ramsgate.

Phased closures are planned from Monday 6 January 2020, with completion currently estimated by 2 April 2020.

A255 Hereson Road will be closed in sections working northwards from the junction with Thanet Road, as defined below

**Phase A – Hereson Road closed between and including the junctions with Thanet Road and Honeysuckle Road  
Dane Park Road and Lilian Road will be closed at the junctions with Hereson Road**

**Phase B – Hereson Road closed between and including the junctions with Cecilia Road and St George's Road**

**Phase C – Hereson Road closed between and including the junctions with St Andrew's Road and St Patrick's Road  
Cornwall Close closed at the junction with Hereson Road**

**Phase D – Hereson Road closed between and including the junctions with Muir Road and St David's Road**

The alternative routes for through traffic are as follows

***Light vehicles only* via Victoria Road, Bellevue Road, Dumpton Park Drive and Montefiore Avenue**

***Larger vehicles and HGVs etc* via A255 Boundary Road, A254 Margate Road, Pysons Road, Bromstone Road and A255 Ramsgate Road**

**For roads that are closed at their junctions with Hereson Road, access will continue to be maintained from their alternative junctions.**

**For those roads that are *cul-de-sacs*, access will be maintained, but subject to delays.**

**Personnel will be on site at all times to allow managed access for residents and businesses when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.**

**Local access to the remainder of A255 Hereson Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed at any time, but there will be no through access during these works.**

**There will be certain times when the closures are lifted, with traffic controlled by temporary traffic lights.**

**Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the roads outside the working hours.**

**These works are subject to weather and other factors which make it difficult to provide accurate timing of the phases; the specific dates of the phases will be signposted on site and notified to local residents, businesses and the local bus company.**
