A255 High Street, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of the A255 High Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned between 20:00 hours and 05:00 hours from 11th August 2022 (excluding weekends), with estimated completion by 17th August 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70594635438-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The A255 High Street will be closed between the junctions of B2014 Newington Road and Wilfred Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while carriageway resurfacing works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A255 High Street, A255 Nethercourt Hill, A255 Nethercourt Circus, A255 Canterbury Road East, A299 Canterbury Road East, Lord Of The Manor Roundabout, A256 Canterbury Road West, A256 Haine Road, A256 New Haine Road, New Cross Road, A254 Margate Road, Shah Place, A255 Park Road and vice versa.
