A255 Park Road, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow for carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A255 Park Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned for 6 week nights between 20:00hrs and 05:00 hrs, from 13th December 2021, with estimated completion by 21st December 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70510486913-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

A255 Park Road will be closed between Shah Place and Elmstone Road.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while carriageway resurfacing works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A255 Park Road, A254 Margate Road, A256 Haine Road/New Haine Road, A299 Canterbury Road West/Canterbury Road East, A255 Nethercourt Hill/High Street/Park Road and vice versa.
