A256 Haine Road, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

To allow resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A256 Haine Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 17th July 2023, with estimated completion by 23rd July 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE27839726978-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A256 Haine Road will be closed between the junctions of Spratling Lane and B2050 Manston Road, between the hours of 21:00 and 05:00 only. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allow resurfacing works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A256 New Haine Road, A256 Haine Road, A254 Margate Road, B2014 Newington Road, B2050 Manston Road and vice versa.

For access to Spratling Lane, the alternative route for any through traffic is via B2050 Manston Road, Preston Road, Spratling Street and vice versa.

For access to Leigh Road, there is no alternative route. Every effort will be made to maintain access for residents whenever it is safe to do so.
