(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & RIGHT TURN)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

To allow road works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A256 Haine Road, Ramsgate.

Restrictions are planned from 24th July 2023, with estimated completion by 23rd October 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE27895482941-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A256 Haine Road at the junction with B2050 Manston Road will be closed. A temporary right turn prohibition will be imposed, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing road works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Walker Construction UK LTD.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A256 Haine Road, A256 New Haine Road and vice versa.
