(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow high speed lining and cats eye works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A256 Richborough Way, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned between 19:00 hours and 05:00 hours, from 30th March 2022, with estimated completion by 2nd April 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40190206093-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A256 Richborough Way will be closed for the entire length.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while high speed lining and cats eye works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A299 Hengist Way, Sandwich Road, Ramsgate Road and vice versa.
