**A299 CANTERBURY ROAD EAST,
RAMSGATE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2019**

To allow essential carriageway strengthening and resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on A299 Canterbury Road East, Ramsgate.

Overnight closures are planned from Monday 14 January 2019 for 6 consecutive nights, from 20:00 hours through until approximately 06:00 hours each night.

A299 Canterbury Road East will be closed in both directions between Lord of the Manor Interchange and the junction with Royal Harbour Approach.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via Lord of the Manor Interchange, A256 Haine Road, New Haine Road, Haine Road, A254 Margate Road (Westwood), A255 Park Road, High Street St Lawrence, Nethercourt Hill and Canterbury Road East.
