A299 Hengist Way, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow high speed road lining and cats eye works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A299 Hengist Way, Ramsgate.

Closures are planned between 19:00 hours and 05:00 hours, from 21st March 2022, with estimated completion by 29th March 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40143224155A-01 & GE40190206090-01 - Kent County Council) . The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The works will be carried out in two phases as detailed below.

Phase 1 - A299 Hengist Way will be closed from 21st March 2022, with an estimated completion by 25th March 2022, between the junctions of Minster Roundabout and Sevenscore Roundabout, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Phase 2 - A299 Hengist Way will be closed from 28th March 2022, with an estimated completion by 29th March 2022, between the junctions of Sevenscore Roundabout and Lord Of The Manor Roundabout, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while high speed road lining and cats eye works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2190 Minster Road, B2190 Un-named Road From Minster Road To Columbus Avenue, B2190 Spitfire Way, B2050 Manston Road East, B2050 Manston Road, B256 Haine Road, and vice versa.
