**A299 HENGIST WAY & A256
RICHBOROUGH WAY, RAMSGATE**

(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

For the safety of the public and workforce during construction works for the new Thanet Parkway Railway Station, Kent County Council has made an Order to impose a temporary mandatory speed limit of 40 mph on sections of A299 Hengist Way and A256 Richborough Way, Ramsgate.

A compulsory 40 mph speed limit will be imposed as follows

A299 HENGIST WAY – in both directions from Sevenscore Roundabout to Lord of the Manor Interchange

A299 HENGIST WAY – southbound from Cliffsend Roundabout to Sevenscore Roundabout

A299 HENGIST WAY – eastbound from a point 200 metres west of Cliffsend Roundabout eastwards to the roundabout

A299 HENGIST WAY – on Sevenscore Roundabout for its entire length

A256 RICHBOROUGH WAY – in both directions from Sevenscore Roundabout southwards for up to 100 metres

COTTINGTON LINK – in both directions from Sevenscore Roundabout southwards for up to 100 metres

The above 40 mph speed limits apply at all times as and when, and to the actual extent clearly indicated by relevant signs displayed on site.

Speed limits come into force from Saturday 5 November 2021 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with estimated completion by December 2021.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
