**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2019**

To allow essential high-speed road maintenance works to be safely carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on A299 Hengist Way and A256 Richborough Way, Ramsgate.

Phased overnight closures are now planned from Tuesday 2 July 2019 for a total of 3 nights, between 19:00 hours and approximately 05:00 hours each night.

Closures are in both directions, with planned dates of closure and alternative routes as shown below.

**Tuesday 2 July – A299 HENGIST WAY closed between Sevenscore Roundabout and Lord of the Manor Interchange  
Alternative route via A256 Richborough Way and Sandwich Road**

**Wednesday 3 July 2019 – A256 RICHBOROUGH WAY closed between Sevenscore Roundabout and Ebbsfleet Roundabout  
Alternative route via A256 Richborough Way, Sandwich Road, Lord of the Manor Interchange and A299 Hengist Way**

**Monday 8 July – A299 HENGIST WAY closed between Minster Roundabout (Mount Pleasant) and Sevenscore Roundabout  
Alternative route is via B2190 Minster Road, Spitfire Way, B2050 Manston Road, A256 Haine Road and Lord of the Manor Interchange**
