(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow planned routine maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on the A299 Royal Harbour Approach, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned in 7 phases, as detailed below:

Phase 1 - between 08:30 hours and 18:00 hours from 14th June 2022, with estimated completion by 14th June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE50337713262-01 - Kent County Council).

Phase 2 - between 08:30 hours and 18:00 hours from 12th July 2022, with estimated completion by 12th July 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE50399766140-01 - Kent County Council)

Phase 3 - between 08:30 hours and 18:00 hours from 9th August 2022, with estimated completion by 9th August 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE50370160398-01 - Kent County Council).

Phase 4 - between 08:30 hours and 18:00 hours from 13th September 2022, with estimated completion by 13th September 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE50322148640-01 - Kent County Council).

Phase 5 - between 08:30 hours and 18:00 hours from 11th October 2022, with estimated completion by 11th October 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE50369467498-01 - Kent County Council).

Phase 6 - between 08:30 hours and 18:00 hours from 8th November 2022, with estimated completion by 8th November 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE50317520205-01 - Kent County Council).

Phase 7 - between 08:30 hours and 18:00 hours from 6th December 2022, with estimated completion by 6th December 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE50310472129-01 - Kent County Council).

The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The A299 Royal Harbour Approach will be closed for the entire length.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while planned routine maintenance works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A255 Canterbury Road East, A255 Nethercourt Circus Roundabout, B2054 London Road, B2054 Grange Road, B2054 St Augustines Road, B2054 Paragon, B2054 Royal Parade, Military Road,

and vice versa.
