**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow gas service connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Addington Street, Ramsgate. The one-way Order will be suspended between number 55c and the junction of Albert Street to allow access.

A closure is planned from 13th September 2022, with estimated completion by 16th September 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW071W118739709-00010-01-01 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Addington Street will be closed outside number 55c, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while gas service connection works are undertaken by SGN.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Hertford Place, Hertford Street, Albert Street and vice versa.
