(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

To allow water works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Addington Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 18th September 2023, with estimated completion by 22nd September 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT12789389-01 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Addington Street will be closed outside number 50, flat 1. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing water works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Nelson Crescent, Prospect Terrace, Liverpool Lawn, Albert Street and vice versa.
