ADDINGTON STREET, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new gas supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Addington Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 22 March 2021, with revised estimated completion by 1 April 2021.

Addington Street is closed in the general vicinity of number 55, to the extent shown, with no through access between the junctions with Hertford Place and James Street

The alternative route for through traffic is via B2054 Royal Parade, Leopold Street, Queen Street and West Cliff Road.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Addington Street will be suspended for its entire length to allow limited essential access / exit from either direction up to where the road is closed.

The Order which requires traffic exiting from Hertford Place to turn right into Addington Street will be suspended.

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions need to remain in force at all times.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
