**ADDINGTON STREET, RAMSGATE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Addington Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Wednesday 22 September 2021 for up to 3 days.

Addington Street will be closed between the junctions with Hertford Place and James Street, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Nelson Crescent, Prospect Terrace, Liverpool Lawn and Albert Street.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Addington Street will be suspended, to allow essential access / exit from either direction up to where the road is closed.

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
