(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow street light column replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Addington Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned between 10:00 hours and 16:00 hours from 30th June 2022, with estimated completion by 30th June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE60712922139-1-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Addington Street will be closed in the vicinity of number 79, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while street light column replacement works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Albert Street, Liverpool Lawn, Prospect Terrace, Nelson Crescent and vice versa.
