TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

Kent County Council works.

To allow resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Belmont Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 6th November 2023, with estimated completion by 20th November 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE10084296062-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Belmont Street will be closed at the junction with King Street. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing resurfacing works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any Southbound through traffic is via King Street, Brunswick Street & Hardres Street.

**The alternative route for any Northbound through traffic is via Hardres Road, Sussex Street & King Street.
Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
