Belmont Street, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Belmont Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 19th April 2023, with estimated completion by 25th April 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50016281280-01 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Belmont Street will be closed between junctions Hardres Street and King Street. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing utility works to be carried out, works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any Southbound through traffic is via King Street, Brunswick Street & Hardres Street.

The alternative route for any Northbound through traffic is via Hardres Road, Sussex Street & King Street.
