(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow crane operative works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Belmont Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned between 07:30 hours and 16:30 hours (excluding weekends), from 21st March 2022, with estimated completion by 13th June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE10092568225-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Belmont Street will be closed between the junctions of Turner Street and King Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while crane operative works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any westbound traffic is via King Street, Brunswick Street, Hardres Street and Belmont Street.

The alternative route for any eastbound traffic is via Hardres Street, Sussex Street and King Street.
