A255 BOUNDARY ROAD, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow various highway modifications to be carried out in connection with a new development, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit eastbound through traffic on A255 Boundary Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 13 September 2021, with estimated completion by 26 September 2021.

A255 Boundary Road will be closed to eastbound traffic (i.e. towards Herson Road / Victoria Road), so that it becomes one-way, westbound only.

The alternative route for eastbound traffic is via A254 Margate Road, A256 Westwood Road, A255 Broadstairs Road, St Peter's Road, High Street, Queen's Road, Ramsgate Road and Hereson Road.

Traffic from the following roads will be unable to turn left into Boundary Road:

Stanley Place, Upper Dumpton Park Road, Finsbury Road, Denmark Road and Hardres Road

Traffic from the following roads will be unable to turn right into Boundary Road:

Hardres Street, Church Road, Chatham Place and Chatham Street

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
