BRIGHT'S PLACE, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new gas supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bright's Place, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 9 August 2021 for an estimated period of up to 5 days.

Bright's Place will be closed in the general vicinity of number 11, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via King Street and Artillery Road.

Local access to the remainder of Bright's Place continues from either direction.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
