TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Cavendish Street, Ramsgate will be closed to through traffic, on or after 29th May 2021 for up to 8 days.

The road will be closed at its entire length.

There is no alternative route. Every effort will be made to maintain access for residents whenever it is safe to do so. This road will remain accessible for the car park, indicated on site with signage.

It is planned that the road will be closed for the duration of the works.

This closure coincides with the May half term school holidays.

This closure is necessary to enable removal of blockages in the carriageway to restore connectivity, carried out by Openreach.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
