CHATHAM STREET, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new electricity supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Chatham Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Tuesday 6 April 2021, with estimated completion by 16 April 2021.

Chatham Street will be closed in the general vicinity of Asda, to the actual extent indicated on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A255 Park Road, South Eastern Road and High Street.

Local access to the remainder of Chatham Street continues from a southern direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
