



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**Chatham Street, Ramsgate**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

To allow new utility connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Chatham Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 15th February 2022, with estimated completion by 18th February 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50098669177-01 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

Chatham Street will be closed between the junction with A255 Park Road and number 25.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new utility connection works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Chatham Street, High Street, South Eastern Road, A255 Park Road and vice versa.
