(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow works to be carried out to replace concrete street lights, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Coronation Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours from 26th January 2022, with estimated completion by 26th January 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE60746207165-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

Coronation Road will be closed for the entire length.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while works to replace concrete street lights are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Duncan Road, Crescent Road and vice versa.

Access will be maintained at either end of Coronation Road.
